Thursday– 4th & 5th grades

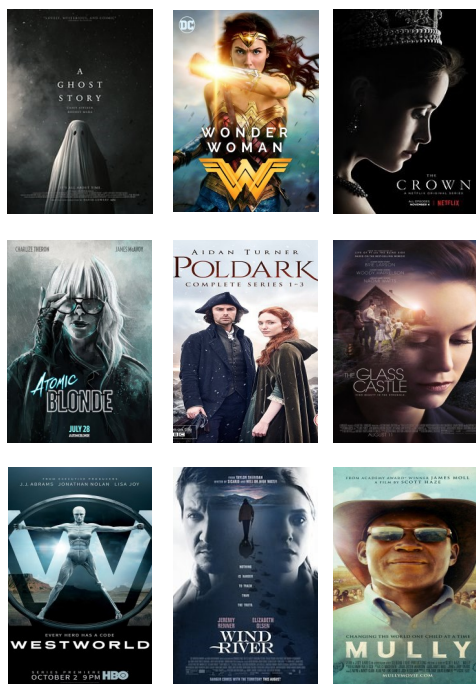
Activities include exercise & movement, partner reading, creative crafting, Cooking Club, Little Makers, ongoing chapter book read-aloud, and lots of exploratory art!
